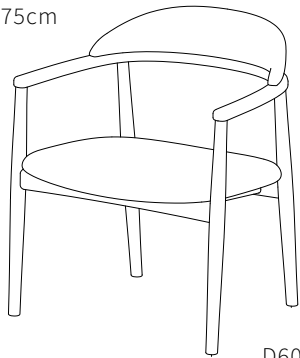

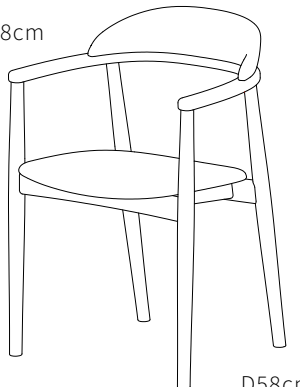

PRODUCT CARE

Wipe spills immediately. Regular cleaning and dusting will help keep timber in its best condition. A damp cloth and mild soap can be used as required. Do not use bleach, acidic cleaners, or abrasive cleaning products. Application of Sure Seal Timber Sealer or similar can create a barrier to avoid stains penetrating the top layers of the timber. Follow instructions on pack carefully as incorrect application voids your warranty. Re-apply every 4-6 months.

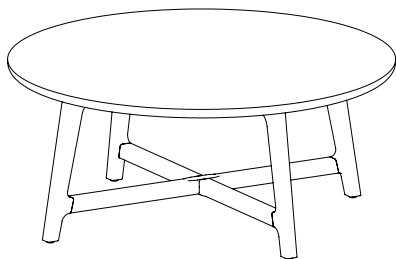
PREVENTATIVE CARE

Wood is a porous material so avoid spills, particularly oils, red wine and pigment rich substances. Even condensation on the base of a glass can leave a ring mark that is difficult to remove. We recommend using placemats, coasters, trivets, tablecloths etc to help protect the surface. These also provide protection against scratches. **PRODUCT CARE**
